

VICE RECEIVES 2021 PRIMETIME EMMY® NOMINATION FOR OUTSTANDING HOSTED NONFICTION SERIES OR SPECIAL

Nomination Marks VICE on SHOWTIME's Second Consecutive Nomination in this Category and 13th Primetime Emmy® Nomination Overall



BROOKLYN, NY (JULY 14, 2021) -- The National Academy of Television Arts & Sciences has <u>announced</u> that *VICE*, the weekly newsmagazine produced by VICE News for SHOWTIME, has been nominated for a 2021 Primetime Emmy® Award in the Outstanding Hosted Nonfiction Series or Special category.

The nomination is *VICE*'s second consecutive nomination in the Outstanding Hosted Nonfiction Series category and VICE News' 13th Primetime Emmy® nomination overall.

The nomination also adds to *VICE's* extensive roster of honors in 2021, including a Peabody Award, Gracie Award, James Foley Medill Medal for Courage in Journalism, an Overseas Press Club Award and the duPont-Columbia Silver Baton.

"This nomination is a testament to the fearless work of the journalists at VICE News," said Subrata De, senior executive producer for *VICE*. "We're incredibly honored that the Academy has recognized our series for a second year and grateful for this opportunity to share these underreported stories."

VICE delivers immersive reporting from the frontlines of conflicts, civil uprisings and political upheaval, taking on a range of issues from police brutality in Nigeria to the continued shockwaves of US foreign policy in Afghanistan, Iran and Yemen. Part one of *VICE* season two premiered in March 2021 on SHOWTIME and will return with new episodes later this fall.
