Newsroom honored for its groundbreaking journalism across the globe—from the George Floyd protests, to the frontline of kids being trained to fight the Mexican cartel, to the disgraced men brought down by the #metoo movement

BROOKLYN, NY (September 28, 2021) – VICE Media Group won five News & Documentary Emmy® Awards including OUTSTANDING NEWSCAST for Vice News Tonight. The 42nd Annual News and Documentary Emmy® Awards announced the winners for the News category this evening by the National Academy of Television Arts & Sciences.

VICE News Tonight was awarded across two major categories including: **Outstanding Newscast**, where Vice News Tonight was the inaugural winner in this category, and

Outstanding Coverage of a Breaking News Story in a Newscast for <u>VICE News Tonight</u>: <u>American Uprising</u>. Additional wins for VICE News include an Emmy® for **Outstanding Short Feature Story in a Newscast** for <u>VICE News</u>: The Kids Being Trained and Armed to Fight <u>Mexican Cartels</u>; **Outstanding Feature Story in a Newsmagazine** for <u>Investigations by VICE</u>: <u>Disgrace (Hulu)</u>; and **Outstanding Graphic Design and Art Direction**: News for <u>VICE's 2020</u> <u>Iowa Brown & Black Presidential Forum</u>.

Coverage honored this evening included reports from correspondents Isobel Yeung, Michael Anthony Adams, Meena Duerson, Roberto Ferdman, Alzo Slade, Dexter Thomas Jr., Seb Walker and Emily Green.

Jesse Angelo, VICE Media Group President, Global News and Entertainment, said, "We could not be more proud and more humbled to win *Outstanding Newscast* in the very first year the category was offered. Journalism begins in the field, and that's where you will find VICE News. Audiences know that and appreciate that. This is the best team in the business - full stop."

"These Emmys were a time capsule of the tumultuous and difficult past year for too many, and frankly, for our journalists, who met each challenge with such courage and commitment. We're so proud of them and the recognition their work received tonight,"said **Subrata De**, Executive Vice President, VICE News.

In addition to the five Emmys won tonight, 2021 has been a banner year with many prestigious wins across the VICE newsroom including **The Alfred I. duPont-Columbia University Silver Baton**, a **George Polk Award**, a **Peabody Award**, **Gracies**, the **James Foley Medill Medal for Courage in Journalism**, the **Sidney Pullman Award**, and three **Edward R. Murrow Awards** honoring outstanding achievements in broadcast and digital journalism.

VICE has produced award-winning content from across the globe including being on the front lines of the George Floyd protests and the devastating war between Azerbaijan and Armenia, on the ground reporting about kids trained to fight the Mexican cartel and a law in India that targets the country's Muslims, and a year-long investigation into the night Breonna Taylor died. Last month, in less than 24 hours, more than 2 million viewers watched a full-length episode of VICE News Tonight, "Inside the Taliban's Takeover of Afghanistan," making VICE News Tonight the #1 trending video on all of YouTube that day.

Since launching in 2016, VICE News Tonight has dismantled the status quo for nightly news. The show has become a paradigm for how networks can defy convention to captivate young viewers successfully through unconventional and brave approaches to storytelling coupled with world-class reporting.
