Preview: BKB Bare Knuckle Boxing returns to Jacksonville on May 31 for BKB 41: Brawl in Duval II at the Prime Osborn Center in Jacksonville, Florida. Headlining the card will be a matchup between 7-2 Jarod "Kid Gatti" Grant (Hollywood, FL) against undefeated Rawand Ouba (Oslo, Norway by way of Tripoli, Libya) for the BKB Interim Lightweight Championship. In the co-main event, Robert Duran, Jr. (Miami, FL), son of former four-division champion Roberto Duran, will take on Rolando Dy (Dasmariñas, Cavite, Philippines), son of former WBC Super Featherweight champion Rolando Navarrete. Also fighting on the card are four former BKB bare knuckle world champions as former heavyweight champion DJ Linderman takes on Terrell Woods, former featherweight champion Brandon Birr faces rising star Yampier Ramirez, former Super middleweight champion Jose Fernandez faces Jordan Nash, and former lightweight champion Monica Medina takes on Brazil's Lailane Mota.

Preview: This week's VICE Sports Arena Football One Game of the Week features the fifth-place Oregon Lightning traveling to Billings to take on the Outlaws, losers of two straight and currently in seventh place. Despite losing records, both teams remain in the thick of the playoff hunt. Of the two, the Lightning have a clearer path, and two games against the Outlaws

will certainly shape their playoff hopes. The Outlaws need to win out and get some help to secure one of the league's four playoff spots.

Oregon is coming off a 50-36 road loss to Nashville. A contender for MVP, Lightning QB Dalton Cole threw for 200 yards and four touchdowns, while adding a rushing touchdown, but he also gave up three costly interceptions. WR Kris Lewis hauled in two touchdowns from Cole, while newly signed WR Donovan Ollie had seven catches for 81 yards and a touchdown. DBs Nicholas Brassell, KeAris Ardley and Angelo Grose were all over the field for Oregon, combining for 13 tackles. Despite their sub-.500 record, the Lightning boast several players among this season's league leaders: QB Cole ranks first in passing yards (1,975), rushing TDs (12), and total yards of offense (2,186); second in yards rushing (216) and average yards of offense (218.6), and tied for second with 33 TD passes. WR Kris Lewis ranks third in TD receptions (14), total TDs (14), and points scored (84).

Billings dropped their second straight game on Saturday, losing at Salina 60-41 and, in the process, severely dashing their playoff hopes. WR Arthur Anderson shined for the Outlaws' offense, catching nine passes for 127 yards and two TDs. WR Darius Prince contributed seven catches for 47 yards and a TD while adding another TD on a kickoff return. On the defensive side, Dewayne Hollis had two interceptions, including a pick-six off Javon Kilgo late in the game. Their record notwithstanding, several Outlaws are having standout seasons: Prince ranks second in TDs (17), points scored (108), average points/game (13.5), and total TDs (18). He's T-second in receiving yards (617). Anderson is second in average receiving yards/game (110.5) and third in points per game (12.0). QB Malik Henry ranks first in average passing yards/game (227.3) and average yards of offense/game (232.3). Shawn McFarland (34.0) and Hunter Swoboda (23.0) rank second and third, respectively, in average rushing yards/game.
