**DMV TRILOGY VS. DALLAS POWER
BOSTON BALL HOGS VS. CHICAGO TRIPLETS**

Preview: In the first game of tomorrow's VICE TV BIG3 doubleheader, the DMV Trilogy (1-4) take on the Dallas Power (3-2), while in the nightcap, it's the Boston Ball Hogs (3-2) against the Chicago Triplets, live from Cincinnati. The Power, Ball Hogs, and Triplets are three of the league's six teams tied for first place, sporting three-win, two-loss records.

Last week, the Trilogy beat the Detroit Amps, 51-45. Earl Clark led the DMV in scoring with 21 points and added nine rebounds. After signing with the league the night before, Will Barton chipped in 13 points, eight rebounds, and two assists. Clark leads the league with 43 rebounds and nine 3-pointers, while his 93 points rank fourth. He and teammate Franklin Session are tied for third with five blocks apiece, while Session is tied for second with two 4-pointers. Dallas squeaked past the Miami 305 last week, 50-47. Greg Monroe led the Power with 18 points and 14 rebounds, adding two assists. Glen Rice Jr. was right behind him with 14 points, plus four rebounds, and TJ Cline added 12 points, five rebounds, and three assists. On the season, Rice is tied for second with eight 3-pointers and ranks third with 100 points and 15 assists. Monroe ranks fourth with 36 rebounds.

Boston got the better of the Houston Rig Hands last weekend, 51-40. Jonathan Simmons led the Ball Hogs with 19 points and three rebounds. Kevin Murphy added 12 points, with two rebounds and two assists, while Chris Johnson contributed nine points and five rebounds. Simmons leads the league with eight steals, ranks second with 102 points, and is tied for second with eight 3-pointers. Murphy's 14 assists rank fourth. Chicago is the only team on this week's VICE TV schedule to lose last week, dropping a 50-30 decision to the LA Riot. Nasir Core led the Triplets with 13 points and nine rebounds, while adding two assists. Chris Allen scored eight points, and Montrezl Harrell had seven points with five rebounds. Core has racked up 40 rebounds on the year, ranking third, while Harrell's six blocked shots are tied for first.
